What's a Critical Injury?

Critical injuries and Fatalities are to be reported to the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training, Skills Development (MLITSD) immediately.

Do not allow anyone to disturb the scene or remove anything unless its being done to save someone's life/ prevent suffering

Regulation 420/ 21 of the Ontario OHSA indicates a Critical Injury includes any of the following:

- Places life in jeopardy
- Produces unconsciousness
- Results in substantial loss of blood
- Involves fracture of a leg or arm but not a finger or toe
- Involves amputation of a leg, arm, hand or foot, but not a finger or toe
- Consists of burns to major parts of the body
- Loss of an eye

Witnessed or involved with a critical injury?

1. Remain calm and summon help
2. Assess the situation and determine if the person is at further risk of harm
3. Do NOT put yourself in danger of being injured while rescuing
4. Secure the accident scene from intrusion
5. Supervisors **must contact** the MLITSD (1-877-202-0008)
6. Arrange for assistance guiding 1st responders to the scene

8. Complete all documentation for reporting the accident
9. Cooperate with MLITSD inspectors and *do NOT speculate*, provide factual answers only
